Bidding: CUT OUT THE OPPONENTS BIDDING SPACE

West opens 2S (or 2D if playing multi 2's)

The important part of the bidding is that East should not pass 2S, but bid a non-forcing 3S (2NT is the enquiry bid if interested in game)

If east doesn't bid, South can make a takeout X, resulting in N/S bidding diamonds

Auction :	W	N	E	S
	2S	pass	3S	? (hard to X)
or	2D	pass	2H	pass
	2S	pass	3S	? (hard to X)

If Declarer in 3S, then lead by North a 5 of diamonds:

Win the KD return

Draw 2 spades finishing in West's hand

Then low club to K

small club, won by South with Q ; **this is called "stripping out the hand"**

Club continuation, trumped

low spade to dummy

and trump last club

then lead 8H, planning to duck, so that South has to give you a heart trick.

(If North plays JD on 8D, then play KD, later 10D will be the 9th trick)
